3.Solo Haryanvi song performance:

Time limit: 2 minutes

For class IX-XI the students can prepare a skit/ mono-acting/ role play related to the theme to propagate the culture and tradition of Haryana.

1.Skit: Group of 4 (max.)

Time limit: 5 minutes

2.Mono-acting/ role play:

Time limit: 2 minutes
